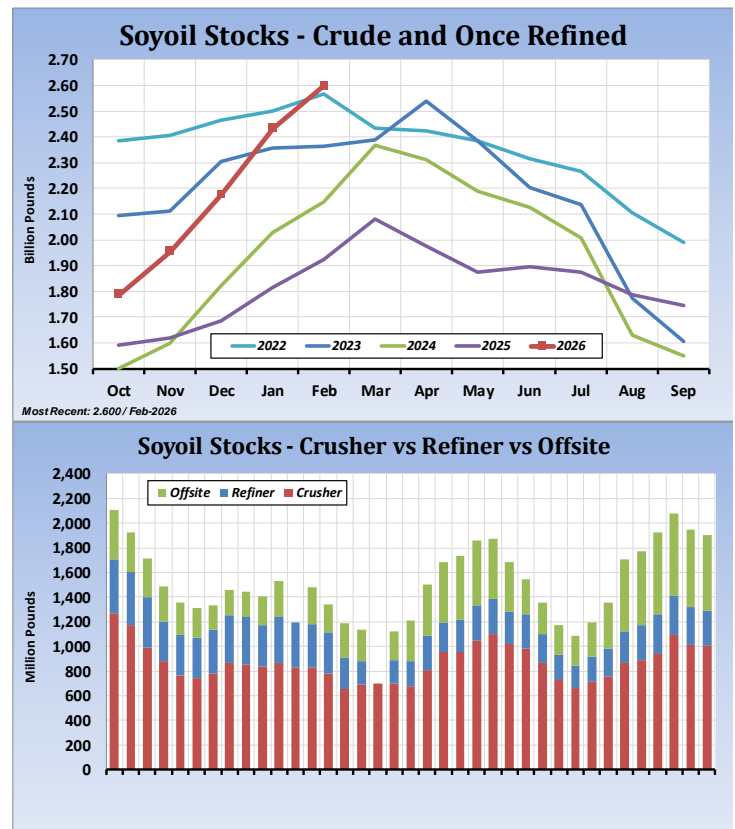

US soybean oil stocks (crude + once refined) in February came in at 2.600 billion pounds versus 2.433 last month and 1.924 last year. The average stock level for this time of year is 2.261 billion pounds. The largest stock level for this month was 2.600 (2026) and lowest was 1.924 (2025).



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
